However, I also believe I will be calling Vegas and lay down some cash on the Huskers going 9-4. Losses like that are hard to get away from. That's right I think the Huskers will lose 2 of the next three games. One of those losses may very well be a home loss. To negative? Hear me out...If I would have told you 5 years ago Nebraska would be 1-4 vs Wisconsin and lost by an average of 35 points and also been beaten by Minnesota and Iowa two years in a row you would have had me put in a straight jacket. Well, we are just a few days away from that very scenario. Hopefully Minnesota thinks this will be easy pickens. I have grown up bleeding Husker Red and I have always tried to maintain that these are kids playing on a very large stage and anything is possible good or bad. I have always supported them and even bragged on them to the point at which I am eating CROW. (Arizona and UCLA my deepest apologies, your 7-2 records in all reality were better than the Huskers 8-1) I also hurt when they loose bad. Spending a great deal of money to see the Huskers go 1-4 in games I have personally been at over the last three years is even harder. Now, look at these numbers. Since 2008, Nebraska has lost 10 games by 20 points or more. It has allowed 45 points or more six times since the 2011 move to the Big Ten. Wisconsin has twice set the all-time rushing record by a Nebraska opponent. Then there is this, Nebraska has lost 13 games since 2008 to higher ranked opponents, 3 losses to top 25 lower ranked teams, 9 losses to unranked opponents while Nebraska is top 25. Nu has just 6 victories over ranked opp. with 5 of those vs higher ranked teams 3 of those 5 wins occurred in 2008/09. Numbers do not lie. Nebraska needs to reverse this trend. So whats next?

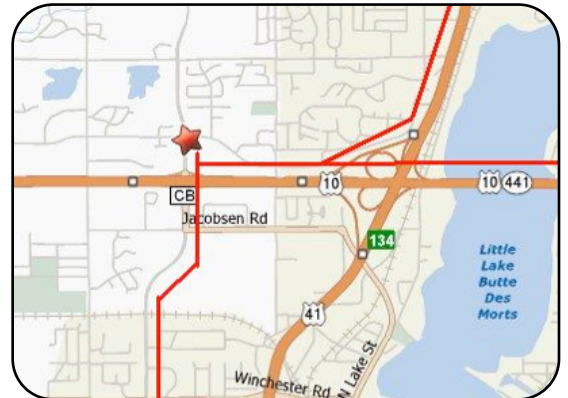
